We see that the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit each speak:

- **The Father:** "and behold, a voice out of the heavens, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well-pleased," (Matt. 3:17).
- **The Son:** "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life," (John 3:16).
- **The Holy Spirit:** "And while they were ministering to the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them," (Acts 13:2)

The doctrine of the **Holy Trinity** is foundational to the Christian faith. It is crucial for properly understanding what God is like, how he relates to us, and how we should relate to him.
