


Creating a Form / Survey in Google Docs (Cloud Computing)
(We will not get into any fancy types of forms and keep it simple and basic!)

- #1 Open [Firefox Browser](#) and go to [Google Docs](#) which is **provided by Google**. Note [embedded](#) links!
- #2 **Log into Google Docs** using [Google Email](#) Account (Username & Password) Created Account
- #3 Once you are at Google Docs which will be **your personal space** in [Cloud Computing](#), at the top left corner, click on the [**Create New**] tab **then Click Form**.
- #4 When Google Docs Form appears at the top Enter a **Appropriate Title** and **beneath** some descriptive Information as to the **purpose** of the Form such as a Survey of Types: Personal or Professional.
- #5 Now beneath the Title and descriptive information is **Question Title:** [_____] which might be **Enter: First & Last Name and/or Position** then beneath in Help Text: **Enter response in box below**.
- #6 The Default (first response) is called **text** and has only a small box to enter information and at this point Click **Done** **and** maybe Check the Box in front of: Makes this a required question!
- #7 Now Question #2 is a little tricky as other along the way, in that you must make sure to view at the left side by **moving the mouse** directly to the left: **Pencil, Resize, Trash**  **Click the Pencil!**
- #8 If all went well, Questions #2 with all the boxes associated with it appears as it did for Questions #1! Fill in another question such as: **Briefly describe the way you usually use technology?** **Help text = Same!** Question #2 should require a small paragraph thus Click **Dropdown Arrow** and Click **Paragraph text!** Click **Done** **and** maybe Check the Box in front of: Makes this a required question! Up to You!
- #9 **Now the tricky part**, at Top Right of form, Click **Add Item!** (for more questions) **then Multiple Choice** Question #3 for the purpose of this activity will be a Multiple Choice Question & Response!
Question #3: **Which describes your Educational involvement?**
Click **Dropdown Arrow**, Click **Multiple Choice** when Option 1 appears Enter **PreK-2**
Click in front of next option **then** continue entering **3-5 6-8 9-12** **then**
Click **Done** **then Help text: See From Below!** Maybe **copy then paste** this Help Text message for all!
- #10 Now again Top Right of the form, Click **Add Item!** **then Check Boxes**
Question #4 for the purpose of this activity will be Check Boxes & Responses for Comfort Levels!
Question #4: **Describe your comfort level at involvement level!**
Since to include Question #4, you Click: **Add Item** which gave Option #1: Enter **Low**
Click in front of next option **then** continue entering **Okay Good Excellent** **then**
Click Done **then Help text: See From Below!** Maybe **copy then paste** this Help Text message for all!
- #11 Now again Top Right of the form, Click **Add Item!** **then Choose from list...**
Question #4 for the purpose of this activity will be Choose from list... & Responses will be Up or Down!
Question #4: **Which describes future plans for movement?**
Since to include Question #4, you Click: **Add Item** which gave Option #1: Enter **Up in level**
Type on the next option **then** continue entering **Stay at level Down in level** **then**
Click Done **then Help text: None needed!** Maybe **copy then paste** this Help Text message for all!

Suggestions and Print Screen View of Forms from Google Docs

#1 Use MS Word Create Questions, Help Text for response, Types of responses with at least (6) questions with first question to be Name & Position (which is an option).

#2 Make sure the form has an appropriate **Title with** information helpful to persons responding to the form to understand the purpose of the Form or Survey.

#3 Questions can expect all the same response type such as Paragraph text (Good way to start!)

or, One Word, Paragraph, Multiple Choice, Check Boxes, Choose from a list, scale, or grid...

After Form or Survey is finished and saved it can be Edited using the Pencil (On right side!)
