Computer Security

- Event or action by User (Accident)
- Event or action by Non-User (Intended)
- HW, SW, Data, Storage, Processing
- Computer Crime is an Illegal Act with PC!

What is a Virus?

- Boot Section Virus 
- File Virus (Word, Excel, Access, etc...)
- Macro Virus (Embedded Coded Event)
- Worm (Copies itself filling or choking!)
- Melissa & Trojan Horse (Hidden) Virus

Detect & Removal



- Antivirus: detect, disinfect, protect Pg 489
- Antivirus SW monitors: Boot, OS, Programs
- Remove and Repair infected software
- Anti Virus: Norton, McAfee and Trend PC
- Many Virus Hoaxes are prolific on Internet!

Unauthorized PC Use

- Access or Use without Permission
- Cracker/Hacker attempts to Steal or Corrupt
- Unauthorized access is considered a Crime!
- Preventable by establishing Access Controls

PC & SW Theft



- ID badges, cards, keys, Pins prevent Pg 492
- Biometrics scans finger or eye or hand
- Common Sense & Constant Awareness
- SW & HW Firewalls prevent intrusions
- Hardware & Software Theft (Piracy)
- SW usage: Single, Lab Pack, License Pg 496

HW or SW Failure

- System Failure: Server, Glitch, Surge, etc...
- Access failure: Username & Password
- PC malfunction: Back Up HW & SW
- Storms cause immediate damage (PC Off)
- Surge Protectors or Fuses: Over or Under
- Ultimate Protection is Back Up HW & SW
